Upgrade of Iron Gate 1 Navigation Lock, Kladovo, Republic of Serbia

The above contract may be awarded to you subject to the eligibility of the proofs when requested, related to the exclusion situations and selection criteria mentioned below, for the amount mentioned in your tender and on the basis of the conditions stipulated in the tender dossier. The contract value is EUR 26,967,250.00.

Please complete a new financial identification form if your bank account details have changed since those submitted with your tender.

To facilitate the contract preparation, could you please confirm that you will request the pre-financing of EUR 5,393,450.

In your offer you have already submitted admissible proof or statement under the law of the country in which each consortium member is established, that each of the consortium members does not fall into any of the exclusion situations listed in Section 2.3.3.1 of the Practical Guide, in accordance with the undertaking in the tenderer's declaration[s] included in your tender. However, each consortium member must, in addition, provide a statement that the situation has not been altered in the period that has elapsed since the evidence in question was drawn up.

In your offer it is stated that no subcontractors will provide more than 10 % of the works and no supplier will provide more than 10 % of the works. In that regard, for any other subcontractor or supplier, the successful tenderer must submit a declaration from the intended subcontractor or supplier that it is not in one of the exclusion situations.

If the documentary evidence submitted is not written in one of the official languages of the European Union, a translation into the language of the procedure must be attached. Where the documents are in an official language of the European Union other than the one of the procedure, it is however strongly recommended to provide a translation into the language of the procedure, in order to facilitate the evaluation of the documents.

The documentary evidences may be in original or copy. If copies are submitted, the originals must be dispatched to the Contracting Authority upon request.

If the nature of entity involved is such that it cannot fall into one or more of the exclusion situations and/or cannot provide the documents indicated above (for instance, national public administrations and international organisations), please provide a declaration explaining this situation.
